I STUDENT PARKING

Carlow University remains fully committed to providing long-term transportation and parking solutions for students within the confines of the Oakland Innovation District. There are limited parking spaces on campus. Students who live in our on-campus residence halls are not eligible for a parking permit.

If you plan to commute to campus, you will need to apply for and purchase a parking permit each semester. We typically have more students requesting a permit than we have permits available, so you should act quickly when the application becomes available. After completing an application, you should pay online (preferred) or in person at the Police Dispatch Center (third floor of Frances Warde Hall) or Student Hub (second floor of Antonian Hall). Current fees and the application are available at **carlow.edu/parking or on myCarlow**.

Student parking is available in Lot A (intersection of Fifth Avenue and Craft Avenue), Lot B (near the Sisters of Mercy Convent), and Lot C (across Terrace Street). Please note that Lot D (off Robinson Street) is exclusively for Carlow faculty and staff.

Possession of a permit does not guarantee a parking spot on campus. A valid Carlow University parking permit must be displayed visibly in each vehicle when parked in a campus lot. Failure to display the permit could result in a ticket. There is a \$25 charge for a lost tag.

Due to parking demand in Oakland and adjacent neighborhoods, coupled with city mandates, Carlow University parking policies are subject to change. The university reserves the right to amend parking policy and procedure on a semester-by-semester basis.

ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING OPTIONS

Carlow students have access to unlimited, fare-free rides on any Pittsburgh Regional Transit system (bus, light rail, and incline) through our mobile U-Pass program, so we ask that you consider using public transportation to reduce the demand for on-campus parking. There are several bus stops right in front of campus along Fifth Avenue.

If you do not take advantage of public transportation, choose not to purchase an on-campus permit, or are otherwise unable to attain a permit, alternative parking options are available at several independent, public parking garages/lots in close proximity to campus. Most offer daily and monthly rates. Visit **carlow.edu/parking** to view a map of the local area with some of these options identified.
